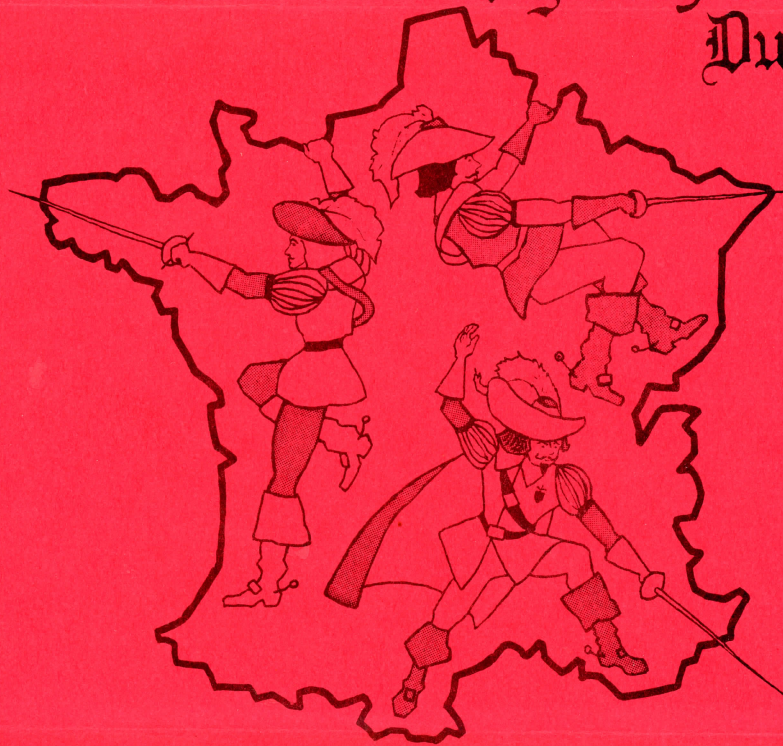

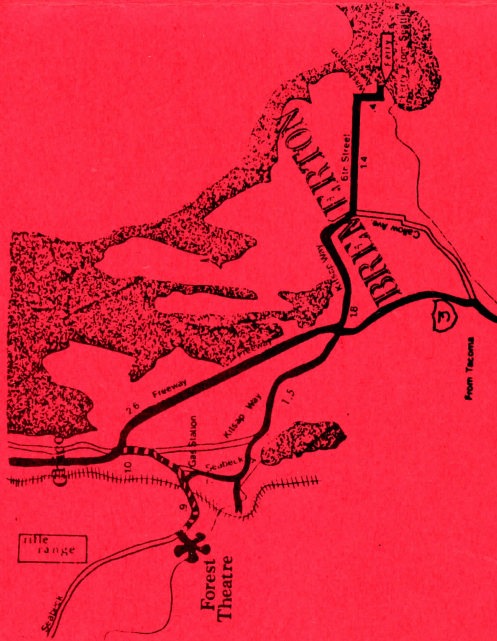

HOW TO GET THERE

The Forest Theatre and Wild Rhododendron Preserve is about seven miles west of Bremerton on the Seabeck road. (See map above.) Watch for Forest Theatre signs along the way. Allow about 20 minutes to drive from Bremerton, or 30 to 40 minutes to drive from Kingston if you ferry from Edmonds. Or you may drive from the east or south via Tacoma and the Narrows Bridge on State Highway 16, or from the north or west via State Highway 3. There is ample free parking at the theatre.

HELPFUL HINTS FOR PLAYGOERS

Bring your friends (but not your pets), a camera and plenty of film, and a picnic lunch to enjoy in the Rhododendron Park picnic area. (Please, no alcohol on Mountaineer property.) A concession stand will feature hot dogs, baked potatoes, juice, soft drinks, tea and coffee.

Dress casually and wear comfortable walking shoes for the 10-minute walk down a winding forest trail. To make the terraced earth seats more comfortable, you may want to rent a cushion at the theatre, or bring your own.
