A note about the Amish/Pennsylvania Dutch.



Their ancestors are not Holland-Dutch, but principally German-dialect speaking emigrants from Switzerland and Alsace-Lorraine who settled in Southeastern Pennsylvania before the American revolution.

They speak a curious blend of English and German and remain aloof from influences of modern society. They practice honesty, sobriety, industry and non-violence.
