My first musical success in Canada was about Joan of Arc, one of history’s best known heroines. There is a similarity to the heroine of this tale. She became my muse and my guardian angel during our creative process.

Martin and Tom are two of this country’s most respected theater writers and I am proud to be part of their creative team. I am forever grateful to them and to the whole team of the Mountaineers Players for bringing *Robin Hood - The Legend Continues* to life on stage at the Kitsap Forest Theater.
