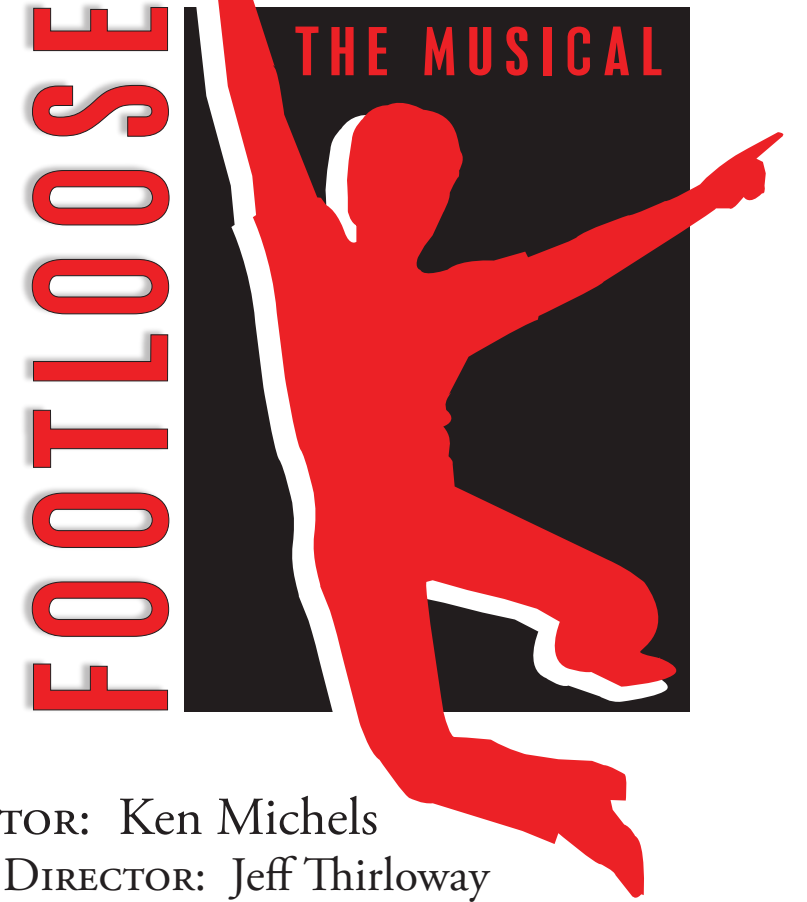

### CHARLIE VAIL MEMORIAL "BIG TREE" TRAIL
