
#### SHUTTLE BUSES – SIGHTSEEING TOURS – CHARTER SERVICES

### BIG TREE TRAIL

One of the biggest trees on the Kitsap Peninsula is located here on the Mountaineers Foundation Rhododendron Preserve. The trail to 'Big Tree' is about 1/2 mile long and starts near the historic Kitsap Cabin, ending at one of the 10 largest Douglas Fir trees in the world (2<sup>nd</sup> largest in Kitsap County). The hike takes you on a bridge over Wildcat Creek with views of Hidden Valley, blooming trillium, wild rhododendrons and many other native trees and plants. If you hike the trail after the show, please be sure that your car is not blocking anyone in and note that the start of the trail is steep.
