JENNY HILL	Edward's high-school-cheerleader girlfriend (ages from teen to 50's)	Mezzo-Soprano
KARL THE GIANT	Giant, fantasy friend, acts/sings/dances, comic irony, stilt walks	Bass
AMOS CALLOWAY	Werewolf, fantasy friend, ringmaster of broken down circus; strong comic	Tenor
DR. BENNETT	Edward's doctor and close friend; older	
DON PRICE	Edward's childhood frenemy, early buddy, bully and rival for Sandra's hand	Baritone
THE WITCH	Edward's imaginary acquaintance, shows him how he'll die	Mezzo/high belt
GIRL IN THE WATER	Ethereal creature who grants Edward his first kiss, strong dancer	
ZACKY PRICE	Nerdy brother, shadow of older brother, Don Price	Bari/Tenor
MAYOR	The good-hearted mayor of Ashton. Turns into a drunk under pressure.	Baritone
ENSEMBLE	Strong dancers & singers for salesmen, USO dancers, cowboys/cowgirls, doctors, townsfolk, mermaid. Tap dance, ballet and acrobatics a plus
